Code of conduct during games

(March 2025)

- 1. Do not monopolize the courts during the warm-up period.
- 2. Before each game, greet the players and introduce yourself to new ones.
- 3. Ensure that everyone is ready before starting the game.
- 4. Call out the score loudly.
- 5. Do not cross a court when the ball is in play.
- 6. Announce an errant ball loudly, especially if it is heading toward another court.
- 7. Stop play immediately when a player from another court calls "ball."
- 8. Let the players make the calls, not the spectators.
- 9. "Out" calls are made by the players on the side where the ball bounces.
- 10. If you and your partner cannot determine whether the ball was "in" or "out," give the benefit of the doubt to your opponents.
- 11. Avoid taking advantage of others' limitations.
- 12. Never criticize your opponents or your partner's play.
- 13.At the end of the game, all players meet at the net to congratulate and thank each other.
